LIST OF MANDATORY PERSONAL EQUIPMENT FOR TRAINING FOR WILD WATER RESCUER – program C (ZVU-WWR-C), **season 2022**

The list below lists all the necessary personal equipment that the candidate crucially needs to participate in the training. In case of incomplete personal equipment, the candidate is rejected from the training. In this case, the registration fee is not refundable.

The table gives examples of suitable equipment for easier orientation when buying. The examples in the table serve only as an orientation, but of course, the equivalent equipment from other manufacturers is also suitable.

1.	White water clothing like 5 mm neoprene wetsuit with hood or drysuit and neoprene cap (we recommend wetsuit for easier swimming).	- Cressi Diver 5mm - Kokatat Meridian Dry Suit	
2.	Strong sports shoes with strong thick soles like running shoes, low trekking shoes or special canyoning shoes (sandals, light kayak shoes or neoprene booties for rafting with thin soles are strictly forbidden).	- Adidas terrex Hydro_Lace - Bestard Canyon Guide	
3.	Neoprene socks if you are using a wetsuit.	- Hiko NEO3.0 neoprene socks - Sandiline neoprene socks	
4.	Helmet (kayak or climbing helmet) with a piece of duct tape on the front side where the name of the participant is written.	- Edelrid Zodiac - Palm AP4000 - Petzl Ecrin Roc	

5.	PFD (personal floating device or so-called life jacket) with a quick release system.	- Palm Extreme - Palm Rescue 800	
6.	Cowtail with a stainless steel ring on one end of the cowtail and big pear shaped (HMS) locking carabiner on the other end.	- HF Bungee cowtail - Palm Cowtail One	
7.	White water knife with a folding or fixed blade.	- CRKT Bearclaw - Edelrid Rope Tooth	
8.	A whistle that works in wet conditions	- ACME whistle Tornado 2000 - Palm Fox 40 micro	
9.	Throwbag, with a minimum length of rope, is 20 m.	- HF Compact Syntect - Palm Pro 20m	
10.	Special carrying belt for throwbag (the throwbag is carried around the waist).	- HF Swifty QR throwline belt - Palm Quick release belt	

11.	4 pear-shaped (HMS) carabiners with locking gate design and CE/UIAA certified. The best are those with a screwgate mechanism and key lock system.	- Petzl William Screwlock - Edelrid Magnum screwgate	
12.	8 m of 6 mm accessory cord (Prussic), the cord should be CE/UIAA certified.	- Edelrid Power lock static prusik cord 6mm - Beal prusik cord 6mm	
13.	8 m of webbing tape, tensile strength minimum 15 kN and CE/UIAA certified.	- Edelrid X-tube 25mm - Beal Tubular 26mm	
14.	Nylon sling length of 170 to 180 cm (climbing anchor sling-loop) width min 1,5 cm and CE/UIAA certified.	- Tendon sewn sling 180cm	
15.	3x AA batteries.	/
